- 4. AMI Education reserves the right to discontinue or alter any course date, tuition or service fee, location, timetable or staffing without prior notice.
- 5. The Applicant agrees to be bound by the rules and regulations of AMI Education in force during any and all enrolments and otherwise to follow acceptable codes of behaviour, attendance and academic performance and show due concern for other students.
